The Monotype Guild of New England (MGNE) is celebrating our 30th anniversary with “ONCE,” a juried exhibition of monotypes and monoprints at the distinguished Brickbottom Gallery in Somerville, MA. MGNE is honored to have Scott Schnepf as a guest juror for this exhibition.

Scott Schnepf is a distinguished printmaker and professor of printmaking, drawing and painting at the University of New Hampshire. In 2008, Schnepf was the recipient of the Lindberg Award, an honor given annually to an outstanding scholar and teacher in the College of Fine Arts. His work has been exhibited in numerous solo and group shows throughout the country, and his work is featured in prestigious private and permanent collections including the Portland Museum of Art, The Currier Gallery of Art, the Milwaukee Art Museum and the Library of Congress. Schnepf has an MFA from Kansas State University and lives in South Berwick, Maine.

The Monotype Guild of New England is a nonprofit organization of over 250 contemporary artists creating unique impressions by working in the medium of monotypes and monoprints. MGNE is dedicated to promoting an understanding and appreciation of unique, one-of-a-kind prints through exhibitions and workshops. Founded in 1985 by a group of New England artists, MGNE has grown into a national nonprofit organization with members throughout the United States. Over the past 30 years, the Guild has sponsored more than 60 open, juried and curated exhibitions for its members, as well as exhibits open to artists nationwide.
